- July 4 : US departure on overnight flight to Frankfurt or Düsseldorf. “Aerial view” of fireworks is a unique surprise of the National Holiday. Arrival in Germany morning of the next day.
- July 5 : iE staff will meet you after customs and immigration clearance. Train transfer to your accommodation a modern Youth Guest house next to the Rhine River. Two, three or four students per large room. Accompanying adults in single or double room. After lunch you are free to explore the neighborhood area in the early afternoon. Transfer to the World Cup Stadium in Mönchengladbach to be part of the first match of the German national team. 35 000 people from around the world will support their teams. Late dinner.
- July 6 : “Jetlag” will wake you up early: buffet breakfast. City tour: German student will guide you to see the famous gothic Cathedral. Lunch at the Guesthouse. Transfer to the Fortuna Soccer Stadium: First match against German or international team. Dinner at Guesthouse.
- July 7 : After buffet breakfast excursion to Aachen, where Kaiser Charles The Great was crowned 800 after Christ. Visit Maastricht in Holland. Lunch at a typical old time market place. Shopping. Barbeque at the Rhine river (weather permitting) with selected German students.
- July 8 : Buffet breakfast. Depart to Fortuna Soccer Stadium for second match against German or international team. The winner of two matches receives the Cologne Youth Club Cup. Lunch at the Guesthouse. Relax at your convenience early afternoon. 4pm guided Cologne City tour to explore the Roman City underneath. An escalator takes you down 23 feet to be in the Roman Praeterritum (city hall) with cold and hot water, serving the Roman Citizen 2000 years ago. Dinner at Guest house.
- July 9 : Buffet breakfast. Boatride on the river, alternatively Cologne City tour to explore the Middle Ages with ramparts and old town gates. Some shopping, Lunch at Guesthouse. Early afternoon relax at your own convenience. 4 pm departure the Leverkusen Soccer Stadium which seats 40 000. Enjoy the Quarter Final World Cup Match. Late dinner with farewell-party.
- July 10 Early buffet breakfast. Lunch packet and departure to the airport. Day flight across the Atlantic over England, Ireland/Scotland. Late afternoon arrival in the USA.

The 10 day program offers three World Cup Matches, 2 bus excursions Belgium / The Netherlands, and three friendly matches against German and/or international youth teams to win the Rhineland Cup.

The 20 day program offers four World Cup Matches inclusive a Semi – Final – Match, 3 bus excursions, and four friendly matches to win the Women's World Championship Visitors' Cup
